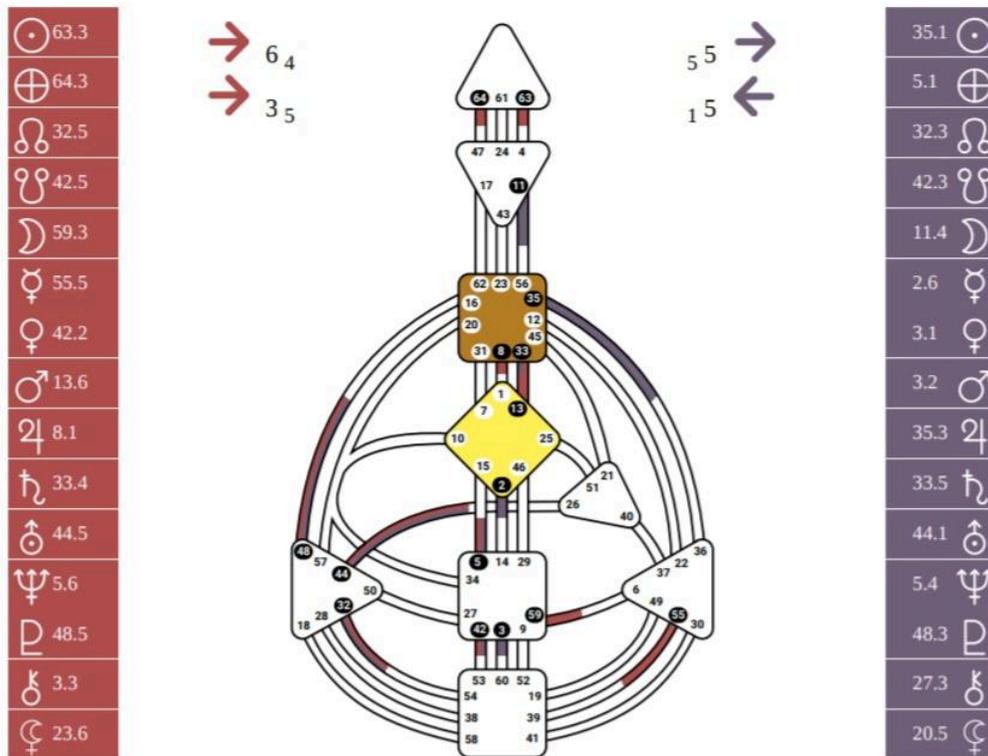

What Is Circuitry?

☉ UNDEFINED SOLAR PLEXUS — EMPATHIC, SENSITIVE, DEEPLY TUNED IN

With an undefined Solar Plexus, you absorb and amplify emotional energy.

You're highly sensitive to the moods, reactions, and unspoken feelings of others.

Emotionally, you are:

- perceptive
- intuitive
- reactive to environments
- inconsistent
- deeply empathetic

You may avoid conflict because emotional pressure hits you harder than it hits others.

You learn by observing how energy flows — not by producing endlessly.

Aligned Undefined Sacral:
